Goal Setting Meetings for 2018

As previously mentioned, goal setting meetings for teachers/parents/students will be taking place prior to school starting next year. This will entail a scheduled interview time with parents and their child/ren to meet the teacher and set directions and goals for the coming year. These 20 minute interviews (per child), will take place on Friday 2 February and Monday 5 February 2018, (between 9am - 4.20pm) depending on which day you choose when making your on-line booking/s. Regular classes for all students will commence on Wednesday 7 February.

To make your bookings, parents will need to:

Log onto the internet

In the address line at the top of the screen, type in the school address:

<http://www.waimauku.school.nz> and click on Bookings, and then click on On-Line Bookings.

Enter the School Code: esbuf press GO and follow the instructions on screen.

This information will also be on the school website under 'Information'. If you are unable to enter the site or are experiencing problems making a booking, please contact the office on 411 8222.

The office will be open for enrolments and Mathletics / Maths Buddy payments (\$28 per child) from 9am to 4.00pm on Thursday 1 February, Friday 2 February and Monday 5 February 2018.

Stationery for 2018 - We do ask that you look at purchasing the required stationery on-line from www.myschool.co.nz

Search for Waimauku School, select your child's year level and follow the instructions on the website. Orders over \$46.00 made on-line will be delivered free of charge to your home address. Alternatively, Office Max have a retail store at 93 Wairau Road, Glenfield. Please check the delivery windows on the website to ensure you receive all required items in time for the start of the school year. Stationery sales at school will not be available until 1 March 2018. Stationery lists are also available on the school website under Information. Please note the stationery lists are based on the school's cost to buy in the stationery throughout the year and is slightly higher than the 'my school' on-line pricing. In 2018, all students will be participating in an on-line Maths programme. This will be Mathletics for Years 1 to 4 and Maths Buddy for Years 5 - 8. The subscription for this is \$28 per child per year and needs to be paid at school via cash/chq/eftpos/kindo please. We also ask that a ream of photocopy paper is brought into school; this is used for various activities in each of the classrooms.
